

PUBLIC NOTICE
MS4 POLLUTANT REDUCTION PLAN

The Schuylkill Township Board of Supervisors will accept comments from the public beginning on July 5, 2018 and extending through August 6, 2018 associated with the Township's Pollutant Reduction Plan as required by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection as a component of the Township's *National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Individual Permit for Stormwater Discharges from Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s)*. The Pollutant Reduction Plan outlines in general terms the Township's 5-year plan between 2019 and 2024 to reduce sediment loadings from the MS4 stormwater discharges to Valley Creek. The Pollutant Reduction Plan will be presented and discussed publicly at the July 5, 2018 Board of Supervisors meeting. The Pollutant Reduction Plan will be available for public review Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM at the municipal offices of Schuylkill Township located at 111 Valley Park Road, Phoenixville, PA 19460 beginning on July 2, 2018. The Pollutant Reduction Plan will also be available for public review on the Township's website www.schuylkilltp.org beginning on July 2, 2018. Comments may be provided in writing and delivered in person or via e-mail or regular mail and addressed to Madeline Harbison, Acting Township Manager, Schuylkill Township. Comments received after August 6, 2018 will not be considered by the Board of Supervisors.
